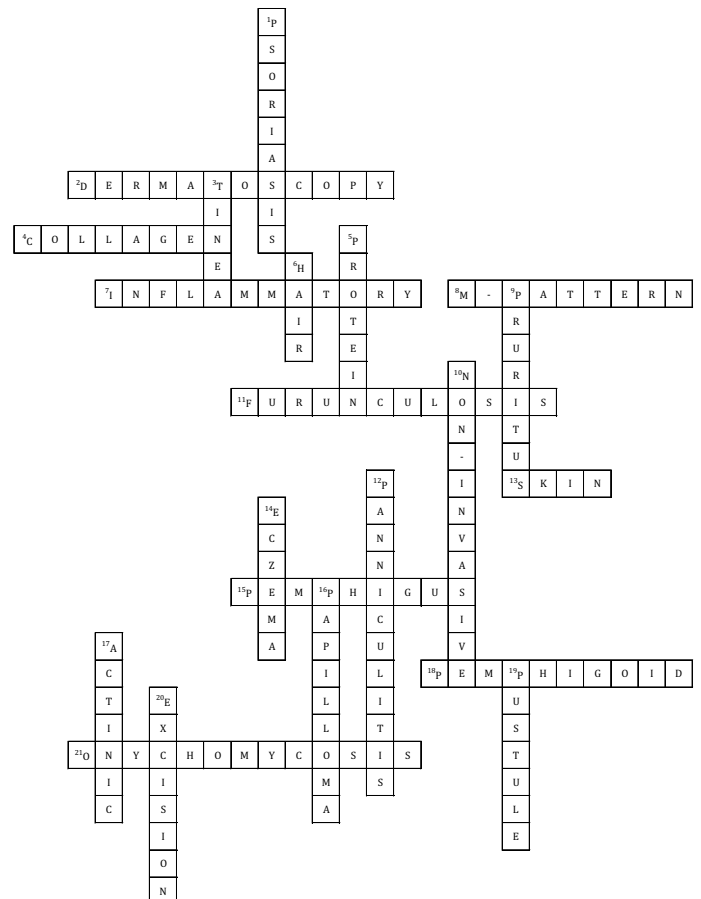

Monthly Clinical Meeting of IADVL WB on 28/03/2024 at N R S Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata

This season's first clinical meeting started at NRS MC & Hospital. It was an excellently conducted program spearheaded by Prof Arun Achar & Dr Suchibrata Das. Drs Banazir, Oindrila, Manabendra, Soumi, Adityendu, Chinmay, Mahasweta & Monika presented multiple cases with extensive discussion.

Following cases were discussed:

1. Systemic sclerosis with suspected ANCA associated vasculitis
2. Multifocal primary cutaneous B cell lymphoma
3. Childhood SLE with skin lesion & pancreatitis like features
4. Papillon Lefevre syndrome
5. Chronic GVHD presenting with generalized lichen planus like skin lesion after 180 days of Allogeneic BMT
6. Lipoid proteinosis
7. PRIDE (Papulu-pustule and or paronychia, Regularity abnormality of hair growth, Itching, Dryness with Epidermal Growth Factor inhibitor)
8. Confluent & Reticulated papillomatosis
9. Eruptive vellus hair cyst
10. Cerebrotendinous xanthomatosis
11. A vascular hamartoma that could not be fitted in a proper diagnosis.

The meeting was well attended by faculties from other medical colleges like Professor Saswati & PGs from different medical colleges

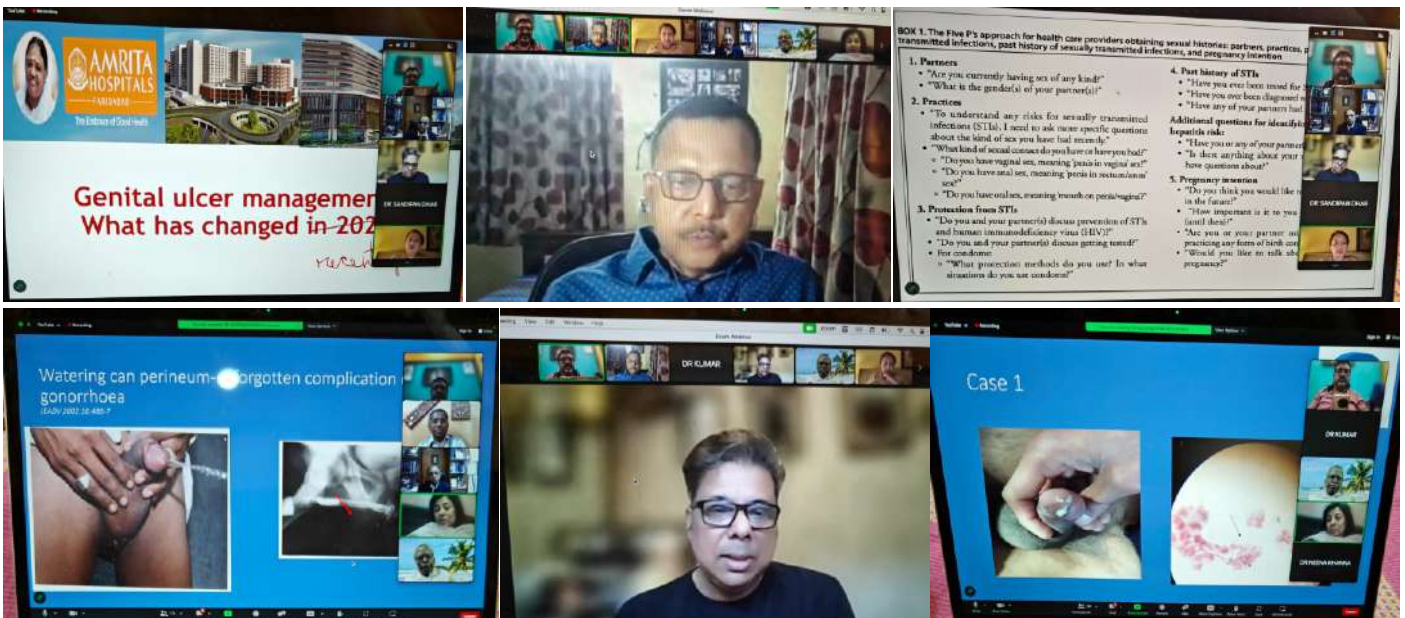


Webinar on DERMA Adhyayan
